SCHOLARSHIP  
COMMITTEE GUIDELINES FOR SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS  
FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2008-2009**

*This selection will be conducted on a non-discriminatory basis. Any student meeting the following guidelines will be qualified to complete a scholarship application.*

1. The scholarship is available to all students attending Texas A&M University whose families live in the San Angelo A&M University Mother's Club membership area.
2. All applicants to this scholarship must have completed two long semesters at Texas A&M University to be eligible.
3. Applications for the scholarship must be postmarked no later than Monday, April 14, 2008.
4. All Texas A&M University rules will be obeyed and upheld with **no exceptions**. All recipients must be enrolled as full-time students of the university, with no co-operative education planned during the scholarship funded year.
5. Applicants will be reviewed as noted on the attached Guidelines Worksheet.
6. Applicants will be reviewed by the three members of the Scholarship Committee and awarded at the May General Club meeting.
7. Applicants are not personally interviewed for the scholarship. The Scholarship Committee may contact the applicant's listed references for further information.
8. Two alternates shall be selected in the event that the recipient(s) withdraw(s) from attendance or does (do) not maintain the criteria agreed to in the scholarship application form.
9. All information received and reviewed by this committee will be held in the strictest of confidence.
10. If a member of the Scholarship Committee is a parent or close friend of any of the applicants, upon request of the Committee, the President of this organization shall serve in review capacity or appoint a non-interested member to serve.
11. Scholarship monies shall be forwarded to the Texas A&M University Fiscal Department to be applied to the recipient's account.
12. A Student may receive a scholarship only one (1) time.
13. Selection shall be balanced between financial need and scholastic achievements.
