(**Due to Health Department regulations, we are not allowed to sell any food items or cooking ingredients at our booth. Therefore, we must limit the jar content to nonfood items only.)

You are encouraged to bring any *unused/unopened* items you may have from home. The dollar stores are especially well stocked with most of the items needed. If shopping is not your thing, we will gladly accept any monetary donation to help offset the cost of the fundraiser!

Items will be placed in quart-size and pint-size jars, as well as various other jars that have been donated to the cause. Please remember these sizes when selecting items. The jars will then be decorated in Aggie colors and have a gift tag attached describing the contents.

The jars will sell for \$12 per quart jar, \$8 per pint jars, and up to \$4 for various smaller jars. Prices will vary, as well, should larger jars be found/donated.
